ANSWER KEY to test yourself reading strategy

1. What is the name of the reading strategy you have been practicing? **PQRST**

2. What is the purpose of the strategy?

*To understand more of what you read.*

*To remember more of what you read.*

3. What are the steps of the strategy and how do you use each one?

**Preview** - Before reading the text, I look over headlines, pictures, graphs, or the first sentence of every paragraph.

**Questions** – I create questions based on preview information. Or if there are questions to answer, I look them over before reading so I know what I am reading for.

**Read** – When I read (either silently or outloud) I keep the questions in mind.

**State**- After reading , I summarize in my own words what I read to help my understanding and memory.

**Test** - After I finish reading, I see if I have answered all the questions.
